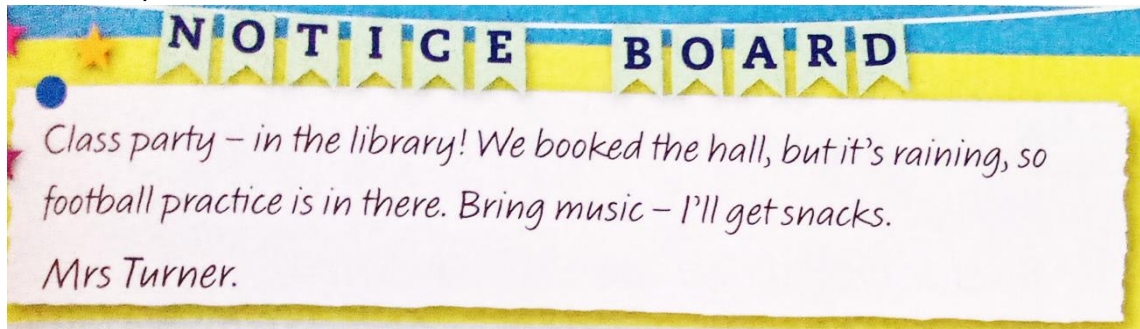


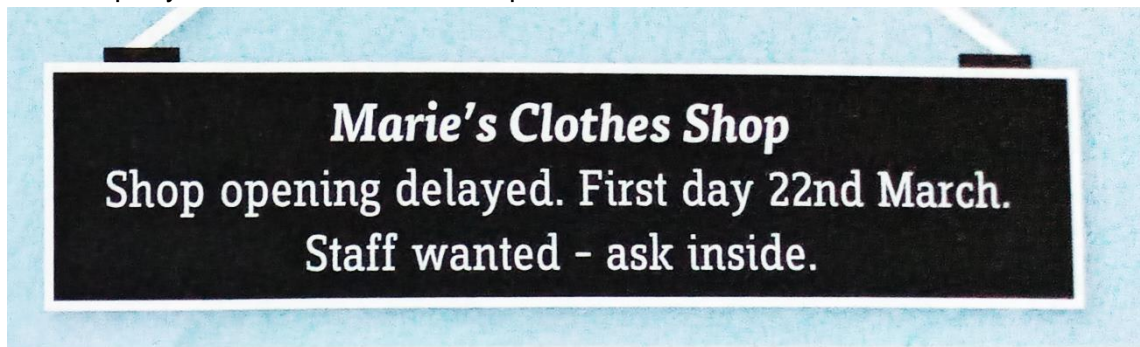

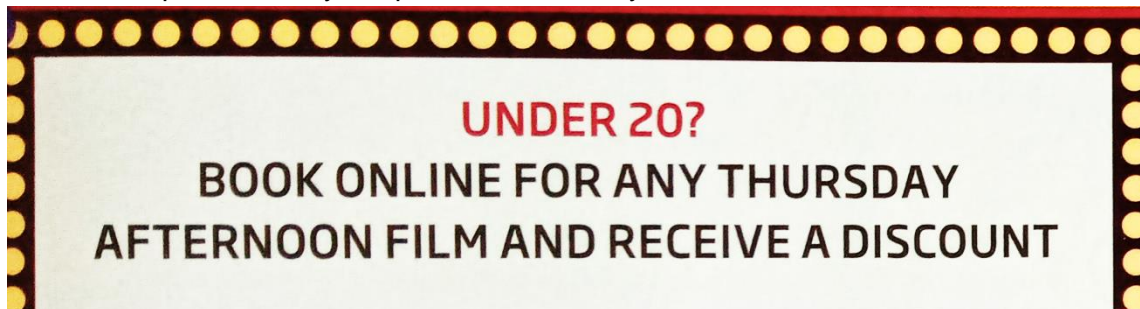
1. For each question, choose the correct answer.




- a. The students should bring food to the party.

- c. The shop is not ready to open to customers yet.




- a. Large groups of people can go to this cinema on Thursday afternoon.
